- 1. Candidates are eligible for Apprenticeship Training within **three years** of their passing their qualifying examination.
- 2. Eligible candidates from **Southern Region only** need to apply.

- 3. The induction of apprentices will be made strictly based on the position in the panel subject to the availability of vacancies. Selection is based on % of marks with due weightage to reservation categories. The training of new batch is expected to start in April/May, 2016.
- 4. Candidates who had not undergone Apprenticeship only are eligible to apply. Combining of Apprenticeship with other institutions is not permitted.
- 5. Upper age limit is 35 years as on 06.03.2016. Age relaxation as per Government of India Orders are applicable in the case of SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates.
- 6. Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/PWDs candidates are applicable as per apprentice act 1961.
- 7. Only Indian nationals need to apply.
- 8. Selected candidates will be registered under the Apprentice Act 1961 for which they should execute a contract.
