

Cropped area affected due to flooding in Assam state








About the Event

Consequent to the onset of monsoons, heavy rains lashed Assam state in July and first week of August 2020. Widespread damage was reported to the kharif cropped areas due to incessant rains and flooding. In Assam, the major kharif crop is paddy, followed by pulses and vegetables.

Satellite Observations

The maps indicate the probable kharif crop area and kharif rice area inundated due to the rainfall and flooding. Both maps pertain to two time periods of inundation - July 10 to July 18, 2020 and July 19 to August 06, 2020.


